

# **Grant Guidelines & Application**

The Education Foundation for Cle Elum-Roslyn ("Ed Foundation") was established to help bridge the gap between the basic funding provided by the State of Washington and what our students need to truly excel academically.

The Education Foundation works in tandem with the Cle Elum-Roslyn school district to help meet the district's goals and objectives. Applicants should communicate their identified need and/or program idea with building/school administration to make sure funding is not available through the District's budget prior to completing this application.

## **Our Vision**

Every child in the Cle Elum-Roslyn School District will have the opportunity to access the best education available anywhere.

**Funding Enrichment and Innovation:** The Ed Foundation funds programs that enhance education in the Cle Elum-Roslyn Public Schools, benefit the students served by the School District, and may include staff development projects. The Education Foundation encourages innovative ideas centered around out-of-the-ordinary experiences and projects that extend the regular curriculum – experiences that are impactful, last a lifetime, and take education 'out of the box'!

The Ed Foundation has identified three primary funding interests. Other requests will be considered, but requests benefitting these areas will be given preference:

• STEM Programs

STEM – Science, Technology, Engineering and Math – Programs are key to our students being able to thrive in the 21st Century. STEM learning provides the essential framework to address the needs of society – things like renewable energy, clean water sources, food demands for our growing population, medicine to cure and prevent disease. The Education Foundation provides funding to ensure students in our district have access to STEM learning tools they need and deserve.

## • Technology in the Classroom

Technology is always changing, so the Ed Foundation provides funds to assist the District in meeting the challenge of providing up-to-date technological training, equipment and materials for K-12 classrooms.

## • Arts in Education – Fine & Performing

Financing art-related initiatives, Ed Foundation funds are earmarked to support and expand fine arts opportunities on a district wide scale.
